



INFORMATION & GUIDELINES FOR MUSICIANS/PERFORMERS

The main priority of the Houston Farmer's Market is to provide a space for local farmers and producers to sell agricultural products. Historically, part of creating a pleasant atmosphere for our space has been the inclusion of non-profit groups, musicians, street entertainers, and local performers.

"Busker" is an English term meaning street performer. There is a wide-ranging variety of Buskers that can participate at Houston Farmer's Market. Performing with everything from puppets to violins, the Buskers serve to enrich the market's already vibrant cultural community. New performers are always welcome at Houston Farmer's Market.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Houston Farmer's Market is open 7 days a week from 6:00am-7:30pm.
- Peak time for music is Saturday and Sunday 11am-2pm.
- Performers and Musicians may collect tips, but there is no compensation by the Houston Farmer's Market.

2. BOOKING

- All bookings are made by contacting the event coordinator, Brooklen Butler.
- All performers are required to fill out a Musician/Performance Application.
- Musicians and performers may email events@houstonfarmersmarket.com to receive an application and to schedule an appearance. Include your website and/or social media, any online press kits, and music samples to listen to.

3. GUIDELINES

Musicians and Performers are expected to follow the performance guidelines as listed below:

- Performers must be fully-clothed and dressed appropriately for a family event.
- No crude or offensive subject matter (as deemed so by market staff)
- Performers and content may not encourage or portray illegal activities.
- Minors must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Cooperation with Houston Farmer's Market staff is required.
- Musicians may not sell goods but may have their own music available for purchase.
- Walkways, loading areas, and other essential spaces may not be blocked.
- Be on time. In the event you are running late call the event coordinator. No shows are not asked back.
